Dear Friends and Colleagues:

This is a remainder that we at the In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority have been able to expand our Home Care Registry services to assist private pay consumers. Our Registry continues to have the capacity to help IHSS recipients and people ***paying privately*** in San Francisco find screened home care workers.

A computer program matches consumers with workers according to their location, language, the domestic or personal care needed, the work schedule, and other job related preferences. People paying privately may receive up to four lists of workers during a three-month period for a fee. Fees are based on total monthly income. The Fee Schedule is:

Less than \$1000 income per month:	No Fee
Between \$1001 and \$1500:	\$15
Between \$1501 and \$3000:	\$40
Between \$3001 and \$5000:	\$100
\$5001 and Over:	\$200

We need your assistance in informing private pay consumers that our Registry is now available to help them find a home care worker so they can remain independent in their own homes. Enclosed is our new flier; please make as many copies as you need. Please provide this flier to your clients and staff – it's helpful for clients to have this information prior to calling our Registry.
